

BARROW CONSTRUCTION AWARDED POLYOAK STORAGE FACILITY CONTRACT

Barrow Construction has been awarded a R30m contract for a new storage facility for Polyoak Packaging South Africa, manufacturers and designers of blow moulded and injection moulded plastic packaging for the dairy, beverage, food and industrial sectors.

The new facility is taking shape in Aeroton Industrial Estate South of the Nasrec Showgrounds, Johannesburg.

Barrow Construction's John Barrow says the

site did not lend itself to the use of a concrete boom pump and it was decided to opt for a new generation, static Putzmeister 1409 pump which is particularly suited to high rise and long distance concrete distribution.

"The new Putzmeister will provide us with high performance, economic concrete distribution and placing capability on this and other sites" comments Barrow.

Quantities include 28,000m² of slabwork involving 8,000m³ of concrete. The project is unusual in that it is a post tension structure that resembles a parkade, but it's designed as a storage facility with a fairly high design load and a floor to ceiling height of 6m.

Construction began in May and the contract period is six months with beneficial occupation due by November. The professional team includes Nic Louw, Architects; Nico de Beurs & Associates, Quantity Surveyors and De Vos Paxton Inc., Structural Engineers.
